1. Download the application form and "Save As" performer's name

2. Complete the application
3. In addition to the application form performers must include a video performance of their selected song. Acceptable performance formats for submission are:
 - a) Email: YouTube link (link may be private as long as it is accessible by Christmas Daddies)
 - b) Mail: DVD format
4. Include a bio (page 4 of this application)-a brief outline of performers musical background & listings of public performances including any previous appearances on Christmas Daddies.
5. Include song lyrics on page 5 of the application.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING

- The Christmas Daddies telethon is the first Saturday in December.
- Performance venues are: Mainland NS-Halifax, NB-Moncton, PEI-Charlottetown. If selected you must be able to appear at one of these venues.
- Your performance must be a Christmas selection.
- Your performance must be **3 MINUTES OR LESS** in length.
- The Christmas Daddies selection committee reserves the right to request some applicants to perform with the house band. If you are selected to perform with the house band you will be requested to **provide the sheet music two weeks** prior to the telethon broadcast date.
- Performers in Moncton are permitted to perform to a CD Track.
- Singers in Halifax are not permitted to perform to a CD track.
- If chosen to perform on the telethon, you will only be performing once.
- You will be notified by phone if you are chosen for an in studio "live" audition. Live auditions, if necessary, will be held in early November.
- **WE DO NOT REQUEST EVERY APPLICANT FOR A LIVE AUDITION.** Just because we don't select you for an audition doesn't mean you are not still being considered for the show.
- **THE FINAL DECISION OF TALENT IS MADE VERY LATE IN NOVEMBER - YOU WILL BE NOTIFIED BY PHONE IF YOU HAVE BEEN SELECTED TO PERFORM.**
- Some performers are selected to pre-record their performance prior to the Telethon. We make every effort to ensure the pre-recorded talent is included in the programme. However, please be aware there are situations that arise when a pre-recorded performance is not included in the telethon.
- You will be notified by email if you have not been selected to perform.
- After submitting an application to perform you discover you are no longer available for the telethon kindly notify the Christmas Daddies office - so that we can remove your name from the selection process.
- **APPLICATION DEADLINE:** The last day to submit an application to perform on the telethon is October 31st at 5pm. (Note-if October 31st falls on a weekend, applications will be accepted the following Monday until 5pm)
